Toward the goal of gaining stability, Park Center's Transitional Care Services offers an array of intensive support services.



Transitional Care Services (TCS) is a 24-hour 30-bed sub-acute transitional unit designed to assist adult seriously mentally ill during episodes of psychiatric instability. Offering evaluation and treatment, this unit is designed to reduce hospitalizations and prevent further psychiatric decompensation. Assessment services are provided to those who feel they have urgent mental health issues.

Core services for Park Center consumers include the following:

- Support, monitoring, and assistance with medications, activities of daily living and case management activities.
- Expedient linkage to a less intensive level of community services and follow-up care.
- Respite placement may be available for family caregivers, temporary shelter for mentally ill homeless, and placement for clients discharged from state-operated facilities or local hospitals, while awaiting placement in an adult residential setting.

Achieving stability and independence is vitally important in the recovery process. Transitional Care Services strives to offer the support needed in order for consumers to attain their goals of a fulfilling and productive life in their own communities.
